Number

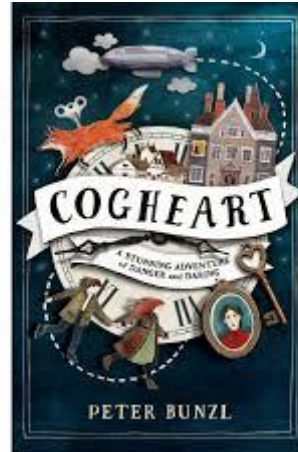
- Add and subtract whole numbers with more than 4-digits, using formal written methods.
- Solve addition and subtraction multi-step problems.
- Multiply up to 4 digits by one or two-digit numbers using formal written methods.
- Divide numbers up to 4 digits by a one-digit number using formal written methods.
- Solve problems involving multiplication and division.
- Interpret negative numbers in context, count forwards and backwards with positive and negative whole numbers, including through zero.
- Multiply and divide numbers by 10, 100 and 1000.

Measurement:

- Convert between different units of metric measure and use all four operations to solve problems.
- Understand and use approximate equivalences between metric and imperial units.

Geometry – Properties of Shapes

- Identify 3D shapes, including cubes and other cuboids, from 2D representations.
