## Maths:

### Place value

- Count from 0 in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100; find 10 or 100 more or less than a given number.
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a three-digit number (hundreds, tens, ones).
- Compare and order numbers up to 1000.
- Identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations.
- Read and write numbers up to 1000 in numerals and in words.
- Solve number problems and practical.

### Addition

- Add with up to three digits, using a formal written method of columnar addition.
- Solve problems, including missing number problems, using number facts, place value, and more complex addition and subtraction.

### Fractions

- To explore the meaning of a tenth.
- To make a whole.
- To count in tenths.

### Shape

- To recognise angles as a property of shape or a description of a turn
- To compare angles.

### Multiplication and division

- To multiply and divide by 3.
- To multiply 3 single digit numbers.
- To scale objects.
